Accordingly, the Hunters and Shooters Society of Australia is hereby declared, pursuant to Section 176 of the Explosives Regulation 2017, to be an approved collectors' association.

Members of the Hunters and Shooters Society of Australia are authorised to possess, sell, transport and store collectors ammunition including:

- 1. small arms ammunition, being ammunition for a shotgun or ammunition for a firearm of calibre not greater than 25.4mm (including small arms ammunition with a projectile containing an incendiary, tracer, explosive, lachrymatory or noxious composition); and
- 2. other ammunition that does <u>not</u> contain explosive composition (e.g. grenades, mortars, shells, cartridge cases).

I have taken the opportunity of including a copy of Explosives Information Bulletin No. 20, covering Ammunition Collectors, for the benefit of your members. Copies may be accessed from our website or by direct mail.
